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AWAKENING CONNECTIONS; CREATING COMMUNITY is a program now in its seventh year of working with school communities and Anthroposophical groups to support healthy social environments for the future. We aim to strengthen the imagination for community by exploring, together, themes of growth, development, and transformation. This work engages thinking, feeling and willing.

COMMUNITY BUILDING- PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

A series of **three half-day sessions** bringing faculty, staff, parents and board members together to develop the capacity to listen deeply to themselves and to each other. Biography exercises and conversation are powerful tools for building empathy, interest, and a sense of community.
